## DOGS

- All dogs must be kept under control and on leads at all times.

- Please provide adequate shade for your dogs.
- The course will be **closed between 14:00 – 16:00** to allow the local horse riders to use the facilities.

## THE COURSE

The trails are mainly on grass and the majority of the course is generally flat. BOOTING should not be required but it is at the Musher's discretion.

The overall trail length will be decided nearer the time, which will take into consideration the weather conditions as well as dog welfare.

## PROTECTIVE HELMET

The correct wearing of a protective helmet is **COMPULSORY**.

The following approved types of helmets are acceptable. They must be undamaged and have a serviceable chin strap.

- A. Cycle Helmet
- B. BMX Helmet
- C. Ski Helmet
