**WHEN:** Saturday, 25th February and Sunday 26th February 2023

**WHERE:** WARREN LANE, Haughley, Suffolk (Do Not use main entrance to Haughley Park)

**PAPERWORK INSPECTION:** Saturday, 25th February 2023 after the first stage

**Please note:** For results to be included in the WSA World Trophy ranking, mushers need to:

- Have a valid WDL (WSA racing licence) for the 2022/23 working season
- Enter in one of the classes eligible for World Trophy points (see list below)
- Compete with purebred KC or FCI registered sled dogs. Dogs need to be at least 15 months of age in all classes other than in bikejoring and 1 & 2-dog classes, where they must be 18 months of age
- Bring **original** KC registration certificates or FCI pedigrees for inspection at the rally
- Complete attached microchip list and bring to inspection along with registration certificates/pedigrees

**Classes for which WSA World Cup points are on offer\*:**

- Bikejor 1-dog (SH & Freight)\*\*
- Canicross 1-dog (SH & Freight)
- Rig 1-dog (SH & Freight)
- Rig 2-dog (SH & Freight)
- Rig 4-dog (SH & Freight)
- Rig 6-dog (SH & Freight)
- Rig 8-dog (SH & Freight)

\* For a class to be included in the WSA World Trophy ranking, at least five (5) competitors need to start in the class. However, not all starters in the class need to have a valid WDL for mushers to be able to gain World Trophy points in that class.

\*\* Freighting breeds include: Alaskan Malamutes, Samoyeds, Greenland Dogs, Canadian Eskimo Dogs & Yakutian Laikas
