- You can use gas cookers / Cadacs, but you MUST have a fire extinguisher or bucket of water on standby
- When smoking please extinguish the cigarette in a container with water DO NOT DISCARD ON THE GROUND. No smoking is permitted in the woodland or barn
- Please keep your dog on a lead at all times
- In the woodland we will be operating a one-way system, this is to provide a safe walking environment, you will have two short routes, more details to follow.
- Please ensure children are supervised at all times, especially in and around the Barn and Woodland
- There are some holes and uneven ground around the area so please take care when driving or walking around the site

- This is a working farm some machinery will be around the barn area, PLEASE DO NOT TOUCH machinery or enter any other shed or barn area these are out of bounds.
- PLEASE TAKE CARE AROUND WATER
- RUNNING OF DOGS IS NOT PERMITTED AT THIS SITE
- Please attend the site welcome/safety briefing Friday at 11am
- Whilst this is an opportunity for us to all make new friends and catch up with old
  ones, please can everyone be mindful that we do need to keep noise down and be
  respectful to locals and other campers. Please do not exercise or feed dogs very
  early or late and ensure that they are well exercised. If there is persistent noise from
