**Arrival:** from **14:00hrs** on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> Nov.

**WHERE:** WARREN LANE, Haughley, Suffolk (Do Not use main entrance to Haughley Park).

**What three words:** *///unzips.impact.evoke*

**Directions to race site.** From the West, take Junction 47a off the A14 and follow AMWA signs. From the East, take Junction 49 off the A14 follow A1308 to Haughley, then AMWA signs.

### Facilities:

**Camping - Friday & Saturday - *£5 cash (per night) payable at the race site ONLY***

**Drinking water on site - but you are advised to bring an initial supply of water (just in case taps freeze).**

**Toilets – *mobile toilets will be available.***

**RUBBISH - We have the use of this venue on the understanding that there is no trace of our presence on the day after the rally. Please take your rubbish home.**

**Catering on site.**

**The Stag Café and Indian restaurant are a 5-minute walk from the gate.**

**Please ensure you have provided all details when registering for this event. KC/Rescue number, sex, DOB must be included for each dog entered. Failure to do this may result in disqualification – see entry form.**

### **THE COURSE**

Come and try out this lovely new venue.

The main trail is approximately 2.8 miles (subject to weather conditions) through a private tree lined country estate, with lots of twists and turns to keep both mushers and dogs on their toes

### **Eligibility for Dogs and Mushers:**

Any dog participating in a Rally organized by the Alaskan Malamute Working Association **must** be a purebred sled dog and be registered with the Kennel Club to that effect, have a rescue number issued by the Official Breed Club for that breed (sled dog breeds only) or have an AMWA Working Number.

Rescues with a SHWA, SSSDR or BSHRA number are also permitted to participate but **MUST** be an AMWA member.

**All competing dogs must be 12 months old or over to compete at an AMWA event!**

- ES 2 Dog Siberian Husky (**Either Rig or Scooter can be used as a trial for this season**)
- DS 2-3 Dog Siberian Husky
- CS 3-4 Dog Siberian Husky
- BS 4-6 Dog Siberian Husky
- S1 Scooter (1 dog only)
- BKJ Bikejor (1 dog only)
- CX Cani cross (1 dog only)
- J1 Junior 12 - 18 years (1 dog only)
- J2 Junior 8 - 11 years (1 dog only)
- DV Veteran (2/4 Dog with an average age of 7 Any Sled dog combination)

**A maximum of 6 dogs on a 3 wheeled Rig.**

**A maximum of 8 dogs will be permitted on a 4 wheeled Rig.**

If competing in ASFDC (3) – 3 dog team, and through injury or for welfare reasons a dog has to be dropped the team must still consist of the minimum of 1 freight dog or you will be disqualified. If competing in ASFDC (8) and through injury or for welfare reasons a dog has to be dropped the team must still consist of the minimum number of freight dogs (mixed team), or you will be disqualified CLASS RUNNING ORDER: Saturday – TBC, Sunday – TBC

**Mushers Meeting:** 07:45

**Race start** - Saturday – 8:30

**Race Start** - Sunday –8:30 STARTING ORDER: Random Draw (Saturday) Seeded (Sunday) CLASSES

**(times subject to change– check AMWA app & notice boards).**

**Rig Inspections:** Saturday from 7:30 near start line (for all competitors).

### **PROTECTIVE HELMET**

The correct wearing of a protective helmet is **COMPULSORY** for all classes.

The following approved types of helmets are acceptable. They must be undamaged and have a serviceable chin strap.

- A. Cycle Helmet
- B. BMX Helmet
- C. Ski Helmet

Helmets must be available for inspection by the scrutineer during the rig inspection.

Plastic lenses are recommended, but any glass must be taped or preferably bagged.

## DOGS:

- **No dogs out before 6:30 (consider local residents)**
- All dogs must be kept under control and on leads at all times.
- Please do not attach dog chains, etc. to any trees.
- You **MUST** pick up after your dogs.
- Please clear up after your dogs, including fur and try to prevent digging and fill in any holes.
- There are wildlife in the park. Please take care when walking your dogs and stay clear from any of the wild animals.

- If you are camping, please bring with you a suitable **fire extinguisher** for your caravan, Campervan
