Please note: For results to be included in the WSA World Cup ranking, mushers need to:

- Have a valid WDL (WSA racing licence) for the 2022/23 working season
- Enter in one of the classes eligible for World Cup points (see list below)
- Compete with purebred KC or FCI registered sled dogs. Dogs need to be at least 15 months of age in all classes other than in bikejoring and 1&2-dog scooter/rig classes, where they must be 18 months of age
- Bring <u>original</u> KC registration certificates or FCI pedigrees for inspection prior to the race
- Complete attached microchip list and bring to inspection along with registration certificates/pedigrees
- Adhere to <u>WSA Dryland Race Rules</u>

Classes for which WSA World Cup points are on offer:

- Bikejor 1-dog (SH & Freight*)
- Canicross 1-dog (SH & Freight)
- Scooter/Rig 1-dog** (SH & Freight)
- Scooter/Rig 2-dog*** (SH & Freight)
- Rig 4-dog (SH & Freight)
- Rig 6-dog (SH & Freight)
- Rig 8-dog (SH & Freight)

* Freighting breeds include: Alaskan Malamutes, Samoyeds, Greenland Dogs, Canadian Eskimo Dogs & Yakutian Laikas

** M1 trail; if run with a Malamute on a scooter, result counts towards the WSA World Cup but not the AMWA championship

*** If run on a scooter, result counts towards the WSA World Cup but not the AMWA championship
